Activity Title	Time Frame	Description
8 <sup>th</sup> Grade Celebration	2 <sup>nd</sup> half of school year (May)	The teachers and students who plan the Eighth Grade Celebration and Social need 8th grade parents to help coordinate the donation of food, materials and the event.
Showcase	Throughout school year	Help is needed with phone calls for advertising, searching for underwritings, finding auction items, arranging catering, helping with sales of merchandise before and during the event, help with ticket sales... list is endless. Just let us know that you are interested and we will find something that fits your abilities and time frame.
Junior-Senior Prom	Throughout school year/End of year	Eleventh grade parents and students put this magical evening together for the seniors. You will plan, arrange, order invitations, sell tickets, coordinate with students, set up, decorate and host the Junior-Senior prom. It also includes fundraising events which are done by the students to help reduce the cost of the event.
PAL (Parents At Lunch)	Throughout school year –Opportunities are available for volunteers daily* – 30-45 minute lunch shift *(Excluding ½ day schedules)	The PAL program (Parents at Lunch) is a great way for the parents of ASA students to volunteer their time at school. Volunteers are needed each day of the week, for the two lunch sessions at ASA. The first session is for 5th & 6th grade students (*Monday-Thursday* 11:00-11:45 A.M. serving time / *Friday* 10:45-11:20 A.M.). The second session is for the 7th – 12th grade students (12:20-12:55 P.M. serving time). We need a large number of volunteers to make it through the year. This year we will be set up in the courtyard with the students.

Parent Socials	1 or 2 per semester	Lots of volunteers are needed to develop and put these events together
ASA Office help	Throughout school year	The responsibilities vary depending on the immediate needs of the school. Volunteers might answer phones, make photocopies, help with mailings, etc.
Summer Reading Book Orders	2 <sup>nd</sup> half of school year (April)	Organize order forms, coordinate with the Barnes and Noble representative, and distribute books to students
Logo Gear	Throughout school year	Help is needed with the sale of logo gear
Teacher Appreciation	School year	Plan, coordinate, set up, serve and clean up teacher appreciation activities including luncheons sponsored by the Parent Committee.
Parent Partner for Ballet	Throughout school year	Coordinate distribution of information (via email) to the families in ballet and help coordinate donations needed for supplies, etc.
Senior Banquet	Throughout school year/End of year (May)	Fundraising for this event goes on at lunchtime throughout the year with the help of students & parents. The Banquet takes place at the end of the year. Coordination of catering, decorations, and clean up for the annual dinner for seniors, their parents and faculty
Student Directories	Summer/Beginning of school year	Collect forms and organize data for preparation of the ASA student directory.
Grade Level Parents	Throughout school year	Coordinate distribution of information to the families in grade level (via email) about upcoming grade level events/activities, donations needed for supplies, etc.
